
What Influences the Cost of Same Day Courier Delivery



What is a same-day courier network?

It is a logistics setup where the package is picked up and delivered on the same day (rather than standard 2-5 days or next day). - Consolidate pickups if possible; reduce weight or size.
- Limit same-day to key routes (metros) where network is strong.
- Compare aggregator options: Shipdaak is one choice, but always check what you get.
