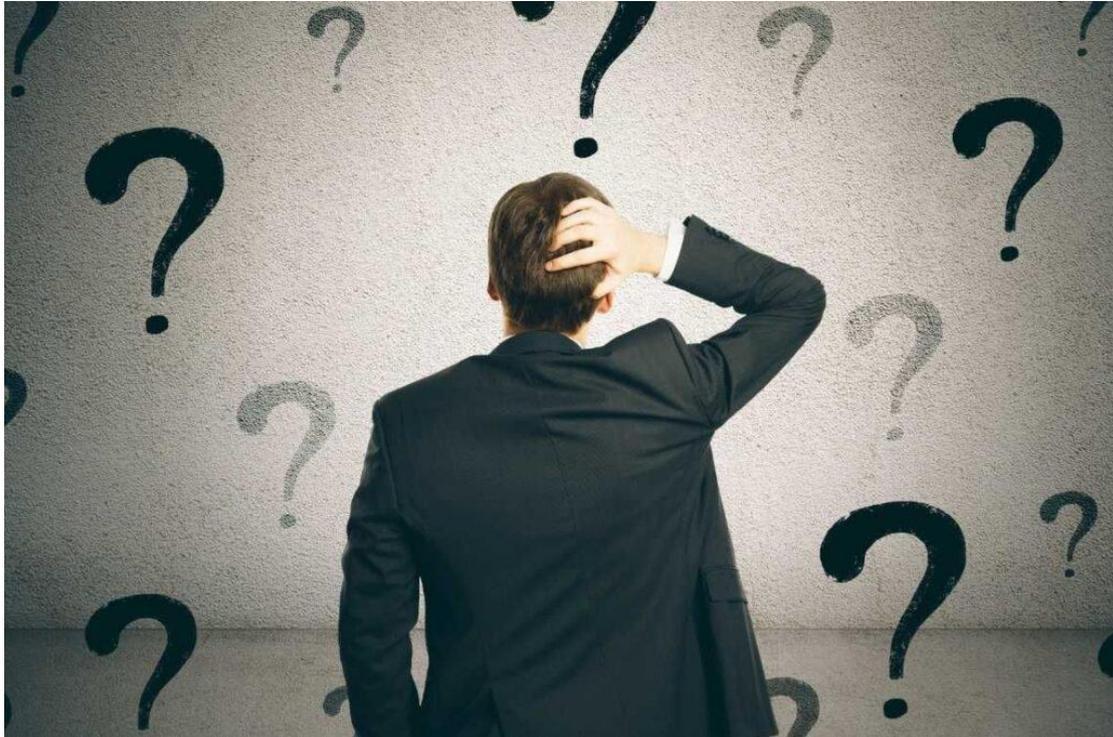


Why Am I So Confused About My Career? A Guide for Anyone Feeling Stuck
