The person needs to wash the tattoo which requires them to use a clean towel for drying or let their skin air dry. The application of a small amount of tattoo aftercare cream or fragrance-free moisturizer enables skin hydration while promoting healing. Regular tattoo moisturization prevents skin dryness while maintaining tattoo design brightness.

## **Avoiding Mistakes During Tattoo Healing**

The healing process requires complete avoidance of activities which can harm the tattoo. The tattoo needs protection from scratching and picking because these actions will lead to ink loss and scar formation. Clients should avoid swimming pools and hot tubs and sun exposure during their healing process. The conditions create potential pathways for bacterial introduction which leads to tattoo fading. The artist's aftercare instructions need to be followed while wearing loose clothing on the tattooed area to achieve proper healing and long-lasting beautiful results.
