## Gross vs. net system

#### **Short and concise (1/2)**


- Net rate is based on reduced gross rate KT95\*
  - Cheaper premium from the start, no entitlement to surpluses
- Gross rate KT95\* with surplus from first year of affiliation
  - With low claims rate, cheaper than net rate

**Decision:** Reduced premium vs. creation of reserves



<sup>\*</sup> Collective agreement KT95: Cause-related premium (age, gender, marital status, etc.)

### **Short and concise (2/2)**





#### The net system

- Low premium with classification guarantee from the start of the contract
- No entitlement to risk surpluses
- The invoiced risk premium is lower than with the gross system.
- Makes sense in sectors where the financing options are rather limited by employees/employers

#### The gross system

- A slightly higher premium at the start of the contract than with the net system.
- Entitlement to distribution of risk surpluses (depending on actual claims rate) from the first year of the contract
- Average risk surpluses were 20–35% of the invoiced risk premium in recent years
- In the case of no claims, there are full risk surpluses; otherwise, the entitlement is reduced
- Risk surpluses are credited to the value fluctuation reserve of the employee benefits unit and increase the employee benefits unit's coverage ratio and room for manoeuvre
- In the case of a low claims rate, the gross system is more advantageous overall than the net system



#### **Decision-making aids**

- Can a slightly higher basic premium be financed by the employee/employer?
  - ➢ If yes → gross system is preferable
  - ➤ If not → net system
- What was the claims situation (disability cases/deaths) in recent years?
  - ➤ If there are no or few claims → gross system
  - ▶ If there are some or many claims → net system is preferable
- Should the value fluctuation reserve be built up quickly to achieve a high coverage ratio?
  - ▶ If yes → gross system is preferable
  - ▶ If no → net system is preferable
