Virtual Apps: Software Anywhere Anytime

Students, faculty, and staff can get secure instant access 24/7, on-demand, to a library of popular software from any device, including smartphones, tablets, PCs and Macs anywhere in the world with an Internet connection. Virtual Apps allows people with a FAU username/password to login to a Web-based system to access these software packages. This access gives FAU students, faculty, and staff the flexibility of using the software on campus, at home, or even while studying abroad.

Before you access this environment, you will need to install (only once) the **Citrix Workspace client** on you device. Once you install it, you can login using the **Virtual Apps Web site**. For detailed instructions, please follow the instructions below.


3. Click the “**Download Citrix Workspace App for Windows**” button.


5. Click **“Start”** when the installation wizard pops up.


6. Accept the License Agreement by selecting the checkbox and click **“Next”**.
