Window cleaning

Entire glass area with frame



Description

Definition / objective	Removing loose and stubborn dirt from the entire surface using the wetting tool with cover and the window cleaner (rubber lip). Suitable for glass surfaces (windows and glazing) and frames.	
Preparatory work	Select suitable products to match the surface to be cleaned (type / square metres) and the type of soiling.	
		Put up the warning sign and take all necessary safety precautions.
	Check the rubber lip of the window cleaner and replace as needed.	
		Fill the window cleaning bucket with cleaning product in accordance with the dosing instructions.
	Cover vulnerable surfaces and the floor covering.	
Main task	As needed: Remove cobwebs and loose dirt.	
	Dry scrub the rabbets and grooves of the frame with the joint brush and then use the dry vacuum cleaner to remove the dirt.	
		Use a wet cloth to wipe the frame, working from the bottom up . Use the white pad to loosen highly stubborn soiling on the wet frame.
	Wipe down the frame with the thoroughly wrung-out cloth, working from the top down .	
		Moisten the wetting tool with cover. Wash the glass area of the window in a circular motion, working from the bottom up . Use the white pad or the window scraper with blade (blading) to loosen stubborn dirt as needed.
Glass	Dry a finger's width of the upper and left edge of the glass using the absorbent cloth.	
		Wipe down the glass surface with the window cleaner (rubber lip) horizontally or vertically in overlapping passes, working your way from the top down. Start at the top left. Dry the rubber lip on the cloth before starting each pass.
	Use the cloth or the wetting tool to remove the dissolved dirt and the remaining cleaning product on the bottom frame.	
		Dry the remaining glass edges and the frame. As needed: Dry the window sill and the floor covering.
	As needed: Polish the glass with a clean cloth to remove any stripes.	
Final steps		Perform a visual check.
	Remove the covering material.	
	Remove the warning sign. As needed: Remove the safety precautions.	
	Wash the used cloths and the cover in the washing machine.	
	Dispose of any waste.	
Comments	Clean the cleaning equipment and replace as needed.
